Education and Skill Requirements

- Completion of legal assistant program preferred or equivalent or two or more years of college preferred or similar professional experience.
- Two years experience in the legal profession preferred serving as a legal secretary, paralegal or related position or any equivalent combination of experience and training.
- Class C driver's license preferred.
- Bilingual preferred. (Spanish and English)
- Paralegal certificate or related education or experience preferred.

Required Skills

- Exceptional skill in the preparation and drafting of a variety of legal documents and correspondence using prescribed format and conforming to all rules.

- Exceptional skill in reception, telephone etiquette, public relations including management of problematical emotional individuals
